

3. Stockton East Water District – Water Purchase Agreement With Aero Pure Water Hauling Manager Hopkins provided the Board with the Water Purchase Agreement Between Stockton East Water District and Aero Pure Water Hauling. Manager Hopkins reported San Joaquin County Office of Emergency Services is partnered with Self-Help Enterprises to provide temporary potable water for rural residential customers that have problems with their domestic wells. Manager Hopkins reported Self-Help Enterprises is contracted with Aero Pure Water Hauling; the proposed Water Purchase Agreement between Stockton East Water District and Aero Pure Water Hauling is to provide potable water to customers that need clean water while their well is being repaired or replaced.

Director Atkins inquired how many customers have benefited from this service. Manager Hopkins replied there are 12 wells in San Joaquin County that have gone dry this year and only one of those customers have reached out to Self-Help Enterprises for their services.

4. Resolution No. 22-23-08 – Authorization To File A Grant Application With The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration For Restoring Fish Passage Through Barrier Removal Grants (Funding No. 2022-2007209) For Fiscal Year 2023, Execute Any Required Documents and Provide Delegation of Authority

Manager Hopkins provided the Board with Resolution No. 22-23-08 – Authorization To File A Grant Application With The National Oceanic and Atmospheric Administration For Restoring Fish Passage Through Barrier Removal Grants (Funding No. 2022-2007209) For Fiscal Year 2023, Execute Any Required Documents and Provide Delegation of Authority. Manager Hopkins reported District Staff has been in contact with National Marines Fishery Service; there is \$15 million in grant funding available through NOAA from the Infrastructure Investment Act. Manager Hopkins reported District Staff would like to apply for the maximum amount of \$15 million to designate to the first phase of the Bellota Fish Screen and Passage Improvement Project which is estimated to cost ~\$34 million. Manager Hopkins reported District Staff will have to continue to apply for additional grants from other agencies to obtain an additional \$15 million from either U.S. Fish and Wildlife Services, U.S. Bureau of Reclamation or state agencies. Manager Hopkins reported the District's cost share would be ~\$4,018,000 of the total budget to close the balance between the estimate of the first phase and the potential grant funding amount.

E. COMMITTEE REPORTS

1. Eastern San Joaquin Groundwater Authority Technical Advisory Committee Meeting, 08/04/22 President Watkins and Manager Hopkins attended the August 4, 2022 Eastern San Joaquin Groundwater Authority Technical Advisory Committee Meeting. Manager Hopkins reported meeting focused primarily on basin accounting and how to move forward with the process. Manager Hopkins reported discussion regarding addressing public comments received from the revised Groundwater Sustainability Plan. Manager Hopkins reported the Committee decided to get the legal representatives from all the Groundwater Sustainability Agencies to draft a charter for the basin accounting framework; they will define how the water budget will be used, excluding cost allocation of projects and the overdraft. Manager Hopkins reported he volunteered the District to participate in the

Board Meeting – 08/09/22 Draft committee along with North San Joaquin Water Conservation District, City of Stockton, Oakdale Irrigation District, South San Joaquin Irrigation District and San Joaquin County. The next meeting is scheduled for September 1, 2022.

2. ACWA State Legislative Committee Meeting, 08/05/22

Administrative Services Manager Carido attended the August 5, 2022 ACWA State Legislative Committee Meeting. Manager Hopkins reported discussion regarding Senate Bill 222 Water Rate Assistance Program which would be funded annually by legislature to help subsidize the cost of M&I water for underrepresented customers; ACWA's position is oppose unless amended. Manager Hopkins reported ACWA reminded the Committee of the coalition letter if any of the agencies would like to support. Manager Hopkins reported discussion regarding Senate Bill 1157 to amend urban water use limit which would decrease the gallons per day per person to 42 gallons; ACWA's position is oppose unless amended. Manager Hopkins reported ACWA reminded the Committee of the coalition letter if any of the agencies would like to support; these bills will be voted on Thursday, August 11, 2022 to determine if they will be removed from the suspense file and back through the legislature. Manager Hopkins reported ACWA, as had CSDA, reminded the Committee to submit any legislative proposals for review. The next meeting is scheduled for October 28, 2022.

3. San Joaquin County & Delta Water Quality Coalition Meeting, 08/08/22 This meeting was cancelled.

F. REPORT OF GENERAL MANAGER

1. Water Supply Report as of 08/08/22

Manager Hopkins provided a handout of the Water Supply Report for information only that included storage, release, and production data collected from various sources as of midnight last night.

There is 82,646 AF in storage at New Hogan Reservoir. Current releases are set at 239 cfs. Current release at Goodwin Dam to Stanislaus River are set at 251 cfs and release to all water users are set at 0 cfs. There are 19 irrigators on New Hogan, 0 irrigators on New Melones, and 0 irrigators out of District. The water treatment plant is currently processing 47 mgd. The City of Stockton is currently processing 21 mgd. Manager Hopkins reported the District Wells total water extraction is 6,684 gpm (~9.6 mgd).

SUBJECT: SOLICITATION FOR PARTNERS TO DEVELOP WATER RIGHT APPLICATION 29835

The Mokelumne River Water and Power Authority (MRWPA), a Joint Powers Authority composed of the County and the County Flood Control and Water Conservation District, applied for Mokelumne River water rights under Application 29835 (Application), which was originally filed in 1990 and amended four times. As part of the State Water Resources Control Board (SWRCB) process, the MRWPA submitted a work plan in 2014 to further develop the water right. The MWRPA must demonstrate due diligence to perfect the water right and obtain a permit from the SWRCB, or it risks having the application denied or cancelled. The SWRCB recently denied the County filing on the American River in July 2022, so it is critical to prioritize efforts to protect the Mokelumne River filing. Very little work has been completed on the Application due to a lack of funding and inability to secure local partners.

To support securing the water right permit and implement elements of the Eastern San Joaquin Groundwater Sustainability Plan (GSP), the County developed a work plan for the "Eastern San Joaquin Geophysical Investigations and Groundwater Recharge Program" (Program) and submitted this as part of the Eastern San Joaquin Groundwater Authority (GWA) SGMA GSP Implementation Grant application to the Department of Water Resources (DWR). DWR awarded the grant for work that includes planning and designing the project(s) to make use of Mokelumne River water. The MRWPA has identified the key steps necessary to complete work under the grant, perfect the Application and obtain the SWRCB water right permit, and the Program work plan will accomplish some of those steps.

The MRWPA is moving forward to formulate, screen, and develop projects and programs to put the water to beneficial use. In addition to making use of Application water, we believe that any project that is developed should also consider accommodating potential partners that may need help in putting their independent water rights to beneficial use. Existing projects facilities could be expanded, or new facilities could be developed. Much, but not all of the needed work,

will be supported by the SGMA Implementation grant. Consequently, the County is seeking partnerships and funding agreements to support the effort.

Work to be completed and perfect the water right permit under the Application entails near-term and subsequent planning, engineering, and environmental work to complete the design and necessary environmental documentation to comply with all state and federal requirements. The goal is to build capital projects to put the water to beneficial use, and in turn reduce overdraft, help achieve groundwater sustainability, and increase water supply resiliency with respect to drought and climate change. The total cost of performing this work is estimated to be \$6 to \$8 million. Development of the water right is dependent on the MRWPA's ability to rally local and regional support, form partnerships, and secure adequate funding to get needed projects permitted and built.

The MRWPA is soliciting letters of interest from potential partners interested in participating in the first step of the water right development process, which is to update the Water Availability Analysis (WAA) consistent with SWRCB requirements. The WAA is needed to confirm the amount of water available for appropriation and provide the basis of design to size water delivery infrastructure and recharge operations.

We would like to meet with GWA Groundwater Sustainability Agencies that are interested in partnering and are proposing a meeting on Friday, August 19, 2022, from 8:30 to 10:30 AM at the Public Works office at 1810 East Hazelton Avenue, Stockton, CA, conference room A. We will cover the project background, current grant scope, potential projects, near term investments and cost sharing.
